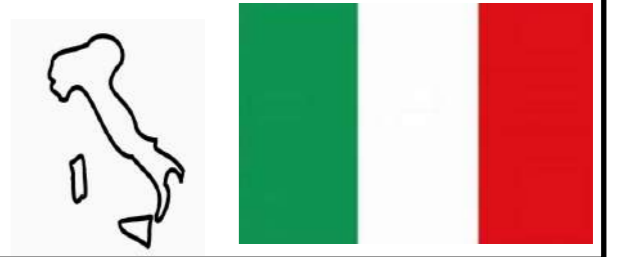

Major mountain ranges	The Alps, Apennines and Dolomites.

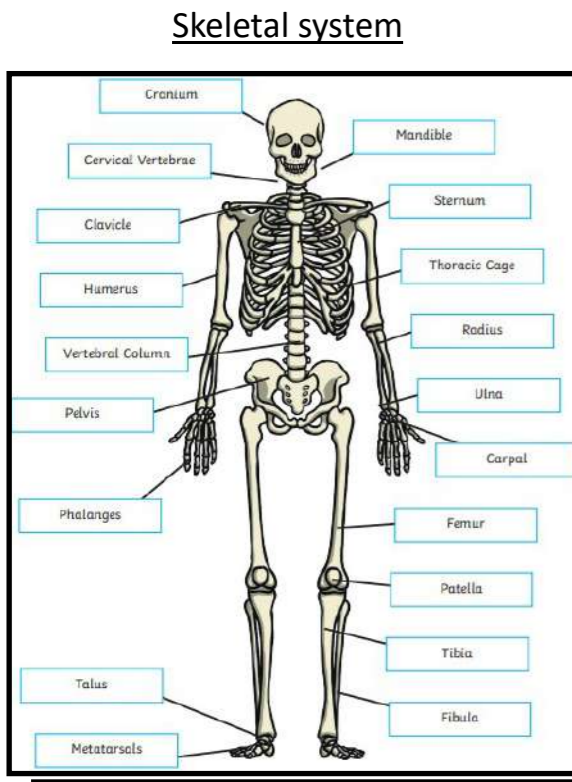
